

- First time home buyers
- Families currently living in poor housing conditions (crowded, dangerous, or substandard)
- Preference provided to those who live and/or work in Glendale
- Those able and willing to contribute a minimum of 500 hours of Sweat Equity in building their home and the homes of their future neighbors
- Those who want to help others in need by becoming long-term partners with SGV Habitat
- Low-income applicants only. Income cannot exceed 80% of Area Median Income (AMI)
- Other requirements may apply and income limits may change
